  - Add campers, fill out camper information.
  - Registration Fee is due at the time of registration.

## 2022 CCS Camp Fees

**Registration:** The Summer Camp Portal will be open from March 1st, 2022-May 1st, 2022. If your child is enrolled in the 2022-2023 school year, there is a <u>NON-REFUNDABLE</u> \$60.00 registration fee. If your child is NOT enrolled in the upcoming 2022-2023 school year, there is a <u>NON-REFUNDABLE</u> \$75.00 registration fee. Summer Camp will run May 30th, 2022-July 18th, 2022.

<u>Weekly Payments</u>: Full payment is due Thursday prior to the week attending. Payments can be made online by debit/ credit card or front office by cash. Cash must be in a <u>SEALED</u> envelope with your camper's name, teacher's name, the amount, and date of payment on the outside of the envelope. <u>The envelope must be handed to the front desk</u>. If you register for a week and do not cancel the prior Thursday, you are responsible for paying that following week's camp fees.

If you neglect to pay for a week of camp we reserve the right to restrict your camper from attending camp until your account is current.

General Information

#### Changes to Account

The camp office must be notified via email of any changes to a camper's account. Notice of change will NOT be accepted verbally or by phone.

#### Hours of Operation/ Late Charges

Hours of operation are from 6:45 am to 6:00 pm. Any camper not picked up by 6:00 pm will incur a \$2.00 per minute late fee. Parents will be required to pay this fee the next day by cash or check.

#### Arrival/Dismissal

For the safety of your camper please make sure if the person picking up does not have a fingerprint registered, they must have a **PHOTO ID** and be on the **APPROVED PICK-UP LIST**. Also, parents, please call the Early Education front desk ahead of time to ensure a smooth transition for picking up your child.

#### Snacks/Lunches

Campers who are enrolled in the upcoming 2022-2023 school year, will have lunch provided to them as part of their tuition for the school year. Those campers who are NOT enrolled in the upcoming 2022-2023 school year MUST BRING A LUNCH EVERYDAY. The Early Education department will provide morning and afternoon snacks.

#### Medical Notice

All campers must have a Current GA 3231 Immunization Form. If medication is required for your camper during camp hours, a Medical Authorization Form must be filled out weekly. We will only be able to accept medications that are in their original bottle. If the medication is a prescription drug, it must have prescription label with the child's name and prescription number. ALL medications are kept in the camp office. All allergies forms MUST be turned in to the office prior to camper attending. All camper's requiring an epi-pen or inhaler must have them on file.

#### Allergies/Medications

If your child has an allergy, please fill out an Allergy Action Plan and turn into the Summer Camp office. ALL campers who need an epipens or inhalers MUST have one file.

Except for emergency first aid, no medication will be administered without written parental authorization. All medication must be in the original container complete with the camper's full name, type of medication, date of prescribed medication, with amount and dosage. Medication Authorization Forms must be completed by the parent before any medication may be given to the camper. Parents put the exact times the medication is to be given –as needed- is not acceptable.

#### Other Illnesses

In order to protect the health of the other children, please do not bring a camper that is sick with the following symptoms: fever of 100 or higher, vomiting, diarrhea, yellow-greenish runny nose, rash, or pink/reddish eyes. Campers with visible signs of illness or fever will not be allowed to stay on campus. If a child becomes ill while on campus, they will be separated from the other campers while a parent/guardian is notified to come pick them up.

#### Accidents/Injuries

The Community Christian School Summer Camp staff makes every effort to ensure the safety of your child. Our staff will complete an Incident Report for any incidents we observe during the day. In the event of any serious accident or injury, Emergency Medical Services (911) will be contacted.

#### Dress

Campers should wear closed-toe shoes due to on-site activities and playground time. On swim days, boys must wear full length shorts, and girls are to wear a one piece bathing suit.

\*WATERSLIDE DAYS- Please apply sunscreen on your child at home before bringing them on campus. Children MUST HAVE a LABELED TOWEL.
