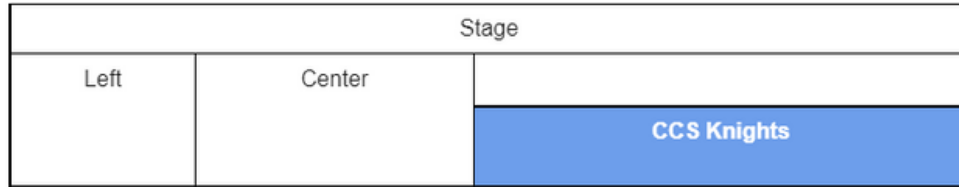
Arete Scholars Donor Portal
