

# Elementary K5-5th Grade Summer Reading Incentive 2025

The purpose of our summer reading program is to encourage students to become lifelong readers. We also want to continue to build their independent reading skills in a fun and engaging way. Reading research indicates that children's reading ability declines between the end of one school year and the beginning of the next; however, this can be prevented by performing one fundamental task- reading throughout the summer.

Our summer reading program focuses on the amount of time spent reading over the summer. To earn the rewards, students should keep track of their reading minutes on the Summer Reading Record Sheet (attached to this letter). Reading **WITH** your child may be recorded as well. Time spent together reading encourages literacy and helps children grow as readers.

The summer reading program begins on **Thursday, May 22nd** and runs through **Wednesday, July 30th**. The record sheet(s) and book reports are **due to the CCS Library** by Friday. August 15, 2025. Happy Reading!

- 3. Neatly Written Book Report on 1 NonFiction Book (using the attached sheet)
- 4. All of the above stapled with your name and HR Teacher clearly listed.
